

HOLY WEEK

AT ROOTED FELLOWSHIP

When we call something Holy we are considering it to be set aside for a special purpose. When Jesus saved you he called you Holy. He placed His name on you making you right and righteous before God the Father and now the Holy Spirit works that “set-aside-ness” in you. We call this sanctification.

Holy Week is a set aside time beginning with Palm Sunday and finding its completion in Resurrection Sunday (Easter). Why do we separate this time as significant and unique? Holy Week is when the redeeming work of God is made plain for all to see and receive. It is when Jesus took all of our sin upon Himself and was killed on a cross to cover over and forgive our transgressions. Then He was raised from the dead for our justification (Romans 4:25).



This year we set aside Holy Week for worship. As the world speeds on around us with everyone going about life as normal — God the Holy Spirit wants to use this time to renew your mind through the Word about Christ and draw you in to declaring his Glory and Worthiness.

Each day read these texts linked below. Worship God by responding to these texts in prayer and song and by sharing them with others. Thank him and praise him for rescuing us from Satan, sin, death, Hell, and ourselves. Lastly, pray for the opportunity to share this Good News with your “one more” and others who need to know.
